Guidelines

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a resident of Guilford, Rockingham, Randolph, or Alamance county.
- Applicant must be applying to attend or currently attending a technical/vocational program pursuing certification OR be applying to attend or currently attending an undergraduate college degree.
- Applicant must self-identify as lesbian, gay, nonbinary, bisexual, transgender, other, or a straight ally of LGBTQ+ people.

Requirements

- Your completed and signed scholarship application and all required materials must be postmarked by March 30th.
- Your high school or GED transcript sent by your school or your most recent technical school or college transcript if you are already pursuing post-high school education.
- Two letters of reference (References must be from other than family members.)
- A completed and signed release form granting or denying various permissions to publish notice of scholarship award.

Scholarship Information

- Scholarships can range from \$500 to \$2,000.

- Scholarship awards are announced in the spring. They are distributed to the schools after the students submit both a letter of acceptance and verification of enrollment to the PFLAG Treasurer.*
